## **Dispositive**

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary body decides:

1. To order the Football Federation of Ukraine to play their next (1) UEFA competition match as host association behind closed doors and to fine the Football Federation of Ukraine € 50'000 for the racist behavior of its supporters.
2. To fine Football Federation of Ukraine € 47'000 for the use of laser device, the illicit banners, the illicit chants and the blocking of stairways incidents.
3. The above fine must be paid into the bank account indicated below within 90 days of communication of this decision.

### **Advice as conditions apply to the match behind closed doors**

The following conditions apply to the match behind closed doors:

- 1) No supporters are allowed to enter the stadium.
- 2) Only the following persons or groups of persons may enter the stadium:
  - a) a maximum of 75 persons from both the host and away association delegation, including the players;
  - b) The visiting association is entitled to purchase 200 top-category tickets for their VIP supporters, sponsors etc., but it is not obliged to take the full allocation;
  - c) accredited journalists;
  - d) police officers and security staff with specific tasks related to security at the match;
  - e) persons carrying out functions related to the stadium infrastructure (lighting, etc.)
  - f) maximum of 75 persons UEFA
  - g) UEFA partners complimentary VIP tickets;
  - h) any other kind of supporters from the home or visiting team are expressly forbidden.

Advised as regards to the decision with grounds

**Written grounds for a decision are provided if one of the parties so requests in writing within five days of receiving the operative part of the decision. Failure to make such a request results in the decision becoming final and binding and the parties being deemed to have waived their right to lodge an appeal. (Article 52 (1) DR).**
